The Watersports Camp Pick Up/Drop Off Procedures

Our goal is to make the experience of picking up and dropping your camper(s) as safe and efficient as possible. Please review the below information to help guide the process.

Pre Arrival:

 Check your camper's temperature at home and screen for symptoms of illness. Do not come to camp if your camper has a fever or is not feeling well.

- Ensure campers have the necessary supplies for camp in their backpack:
 - * Sunscreen
 - * Filled reusable water bottle
 - * Swimsuit and towel
 - * Sweatshirt/Sweatpants
 - * Face covering and plastic ziplock bag to store it.
 - * Forms if you have not yet submitted them, or better, complete the waiver online at watersportscamp.com/waiver

Drop Off Procedure:

- Line up in the right lane of the driveway in front of MBAC. We will greet you shortly.
- Parents must stay in the vehicle.
- Ensure all occupants of the vehicle are wearing face coverings.
- When staff member in an orange vest greets you either in front of the building, or in the 3-minute loading zone roll down both your and your campers windows.
- Answer the daily health screening questions.
- Has your camper(s) had any of the following symptoms:
 - Cough Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing Fever Chills Muscle Pain Sore throat New loss of taste or smell Nausea Vomiting Diarrhea
- ♦ Has your camper(s) been in contact with anyone suspected or diagnosed with COVID19?
- ♦ Temperature check No fever of 100°F or greater
- ♦ No observed symptoms of illness
- Once your child has left your car, move out of the drop off area promptly and safely as possible. Be careful backing out of the angled parking spots.

Pick Up Procedure:

- Line up to the right lane of the driveway in front of MBAC.
- One of our staff in the orange vest will greet you and radio for your camper to come to your vehicle.
- Our staff will verify the identity of the authorized pick up person using the codeword you set up at registration. Please ensure that all authorized pick up persons know the code word.
- Once your campers are loaded please move out of the pick up area promptly and safely.

Pick Up/Drop Off Tips

- » Please say your goodbyes while waiting in line so your child can exit the car quickly.
- » Pull forward to the farthest available staff person. We will keep moving vehicles forward to spots in the 3-minute loading zone as they become available.
- » Due to the closure of our showers and changing areas, campers may still be wet and sandy at pick up. Please plan accordingly.
